

- Fully-suspended design including a galvanized heavy duty track and trolleys.




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TYPICAL CONNECTION / ASSEMBLY DETAIL

Please refer to the illustrations below for the assembly of your gate and the proper hardware to use for each connection.




STEP I

CENTERLINES AND POST ASSEMBLY

Using a chalk line,mark out the centerlines of each post. (refer to installation drawings)

3 types of post are available. Refer to your installation drawings to know which one is included.




FOR TYPE 1,2 \$ 3

ANCHORING


Anchor the base plates type $1 \notin 2$ using 3/8"x2 3/4" and for type 3, 5/8" x 4 1/2"wedge bolt anchors (not provided).





Hammer drill a hole with the same nominal diameter and at least as deep as the length of the anchor



FOR TYPE 1,2 # 3 BRACED TO RACKING







STEP 2 BRACKETS AND TRACKS

Slide the tracks into the brackets by making sure tracks arrives flush with the outside edge of the end brackets on each extremities. Two adjoining tracks are centered within a central bracket. See your installation drawings for details.


Drill the posts and bolt the brackets to each post using Ø1/4"x 3" carriage bolts. Make sure the track is leveled. Refer to DETAIL A.



Single gate should be installed in front of the posts. If double tracks are included, fasten one bracket on the front and one on the back of the post using the same carriage bolt.


STEP 3 INSTALL TROLLEY

Install trolley assembly into predrilled holes on top of the door frame. Leave a I " clearance between the top of door and bottom of wheels.Slide the assembled door into track.




STEP 4 SECURE TROLLEY


Once the trolleys are placed in the track, slide the door to fully clear the opening. Insert a carriage bolt directly beside the last trolley wheel to prevent the door from slipping out of the track. Repeat the same process on the other side. Slide the door shut to close the opening, allowing it to rest on the door stopper. Insert a carriage bolt directly beside the first trolley wheel.



STEP 5 DOOR STOPPER

Bolt the stopper centered on the side of the post where the door closes.
